
Dear Chairman Conyers and Chairman Johnson:

As you draw up the witness list for the Committee's upcoming hearings on minority-owned radio stations, we would like to encourage you to include a representative of the Hispanic-owned radio community as a witness. Amador Bustos could fill that role on the panel.

Mr. Bustos is one of the brightest players in the country's Spanish-language radio markets. With his brother John, Mr. Bustos built his first company, Z-Spanish Media, from the ground up and ran it until its merger with a larger company in 2000. His current company, Bustos Media, which he and his brother founded in 2003, has grown into a medium-sized network broadcasting in several markets. Mr. Bustos knows at firsthand the challenges faced by minority-owned stations and those aimed at minority listeners. He has the experience of a small- and medium-sized owner and could provide a welcome perspective at the hearings.

The challenges faced by minority-owned radio stations are of great interest to us, and we look forward to probing the matter alongside you. Thank you for your consideration of this suggestion and for your leadership on this important issue.
